

TREE PROGRAM

We are currently planting trees around our site to beautify the Hall of Fame for years to come. The cost to have a tree planted is \$1500. This will allow us to plant the tree and look after it for years to come. Along with each tree comes a plaque containing your words and some information about the tree.

Limited types of trees are available and we only plant in the spring and fall.

1. Sugar Maple (sensitive to drought/heat)
2. Red Maple (prefers moist soil but is intermediate to drought/heat)
3. Silver Maple (very resistant to drought/heat and fast growing)
4. Tulip Tree (prefers moist soil but is intermediate to drought/heat)
5. Bur Oak (resistant to drought/heat)
6. Red Oak (resistant to drought/heat and relatively fast growing)
7. Swamp White Oak (resistant to drought/heat)
8. Hackberry (resistant to drought/heat and relatively fast growing)
9. Kentucky Coffee Tree (resistant to drought/heat)
